# Introduction 會議簡介

In 2025, the world marks the 30th anniversary of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action, which continuously reviews and motivates actions for gender equality. The UN Women not only convenes international experiences to accelerate the implementation of the BPfA but also keeps calling attention to the impacts of global challenges on women and girls. In addition, while women face heavier social and economic burdens, they encounter layers of structural inequality and multi-discrimination that hinder their participation in decision-making and public affairs. These global challenges also deeply affect women's socioeconomic conditions in Taiwan, underscoring the urgent need to continue advancing gender equality policies.

Against this backdrop, the symposium will be structured around three thematic sessions, focusing on the integration of gender perspectives into sustainability, digital transformation, and international trade. Session 1: Women's Participation in Sustainable Development will examine how women play a decisive role in green energy, net-zero transitions, and environmental governance, highlighting their contributions to emerging industries. Session 2: Digital Governance and Online Gender-Based Violence will address the challenges arising from rapidly evolving technologies, particularly the erosion of women's rights through digital violence, and emphasize the creation of safe and inclusive digital spaces. Session 3: Mainstreaming Gender in Global Trade Policies and Practices will focus on embedding gender perspectives into trade policies and mechanisms in the context of globalization, with insights from international organizations, public and private sectors, and cross-economy practices to strengthen women's visibility in the global economy.

2025 年適逢《北京宣言暨行動綱領》三十周年，國際社會正持續檢視推動性別平等之行動進展。聯合國婦女署除透過每年舉行的婦女地位委員會年會，匯集各國經驗、加速落實行動綱領外，亦不斷呼籲正視全球挑戰對女性造成之影響。尤其在 COVID-19 疫情後與極端氣候之下，女性承受更為嚴峻之經濟與社會層面衝擊，同時由於長期結構性不平等與多重歧視，使其在生活重建與參與公共決策上面臨更多障礙。此等全球性挑戰同樣影響著臺灣女性之社會經濟條件，反映持續推動性別平等政策之迫切性。

在此背景下，本研討會將以三大主題展開，聚焦性別議題於永續、數位與經貿等關鍵領域之實踐。場次一「永續發展中之女性參與」將探討女性如何在綠色能源、淨零轉型及環境治理中發揮決策力與行動力，並彰顯其推動新興產業之關鍵角色；場次二「數位治理與數位性別暴力」將回應數位科技快速演進下之挑戰，特別是數位暴力對女性權益之侵蝕，強調建構安全且包容之數位環境；場次三「國際貿易性別主流化」將聚焦於全球化背景下，如何將性別視角納入貿易政策與機制，並藉由國際組織、公私部門與跨國經驗分享，促進女性在經濟全球化中之能見度與影響力。

# Our Visions 會議宗旨

- 1 Foster cross-border and cross-sector dialogue by convening policymakers, private sector leaders, and scholars to build an international consensus on women's economic participation and gender mainstreaming.

- 2 Strengthen international networks and cooperation to enhance Taiwan's and global women's visibility and impact in digital inclusion and sustainable development.

- 3 Generate concrete policy and practice recommendations by sharing case studies and strategies on sustainability, digital governance, and gender-responsive trade.

Antonia C3smica Orellana Guarello is a journalist with a specialization in Media Management from the Institute of Communication and Image at the University of Chile (2014). She has devoted an important part of her professional career to supporting the development and outreach of various social and political organizations in the country, standing out for her commitment to the feminist movement both in Chile and across Latin America.

She was a member of the School of Popular Communication from 2012 to 2015, and from that year until 2020 she served as an associate member of the Chilean Network against Violence towards Women in the Metropolitan Region.

In 2017, she joined the Gender Programmatic Team for the presidential candidacy of Beatriz S3nchez. Three years later, she became coordinator of the Broad Front for the legislative initiative on parity in the constitutional process, as well as coordinator of the Women's Opposition Network and the campaign "United for Approval."

Together with Marcela Sandoval, she co-authored the monitoring report "Violence against Women in Chile during the COVID-19 Pandemic: An Absent State" (2020), which was submitted to the UN High Commissioner Dubravka Šimonović.

For the 2021 presidential election, she was in charge of Social Organizations for the campaign team of President Gabriel Boric and was also part of the feminist team that contributed to the Government Program.

In recent years, Shih-I has centered on integrating gender perspectives into organizational governance, fostering cross-generational communication and collaboration, and exploring the implications of AI and other digital technologies for gender equality. She is currently working with colleagues to design DEI-focused teaching methods that can better equip practitioners in women's organizations to create lasting impact.

Now, Dr. Chen also serves as the Captain of SDG.SHERO — a trainees' community dedicated to empowering more women and girls to actively participate in the energy transition and climate action, demonstrating that the power to change the world knows no gender.

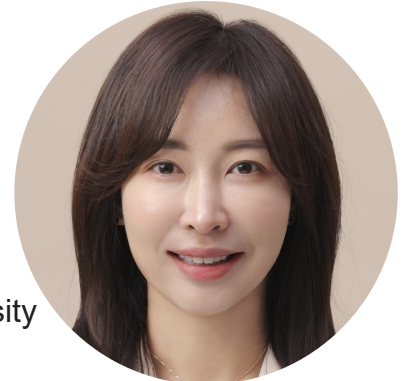

Ji-Yeon Lee is Professor of Counseling Psychology at Hankuk University of Foreign Studies, where she also serves as Dean of Student Affairs. She founded the UX Psychology Program, reflecting her commitment to bridging psychological science with human-centered design, including trauma-informed UX approaches for the prevention and intervention of non-consensual intimate image (NCII) harms.

Trained as a counseling psychologist at Purdue University (Ph.D.), she is a Licensed Psychologist in New York State. Before joining HUFSS, she held faculty positions at Seton Hall University and the University of Texas at Tyler.

Her professional service includes leadership roles in the Korean Counseling Psychology Association as well as past leadership roles with the American Psychological Association. Internationally, she contributes her expertise to the Kering Foundation Experts Committee, the Meta Suicide & Self Injury Advisory Committee, and the Meta Women's Safety Advisory Board. She also serves on the Bondee User Safety Advisory Board, advising on digital platform safety.

Her work integrates counseling psychology, digital safety, and UX design, with a strong focus on protecting vulnerable populations and advancing gender equity in online environments

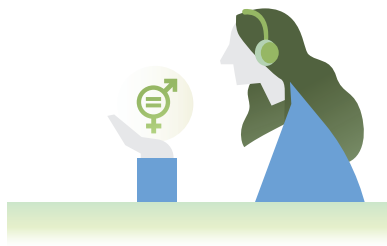
