Rules:

1. Committee members meet with NGOs (1) ~ (4)
Each organization will have a maximum of 3 minutes to speak. The organization(s) that submitted reports/shadow reports for the relevant articles will have priority to speak. Then the Review Committee will pose questions and the NGOs will response. If there is time left after the organization(s) finishes speaking or waive their right to speak, then the remaining organizations will be given the floor.
2. Review session (1) ~ (4)
During the review of each Article, the review committee members will ask questions, which will be answered by the government representative(s). In principle, questions and answers will be limited to five minutes in duration, and each committee member will ask no more than three questions.
3. Committee members meet with NGOs (5)
The review committee members will ask questions, which will be answered by the NGO representative(s).
