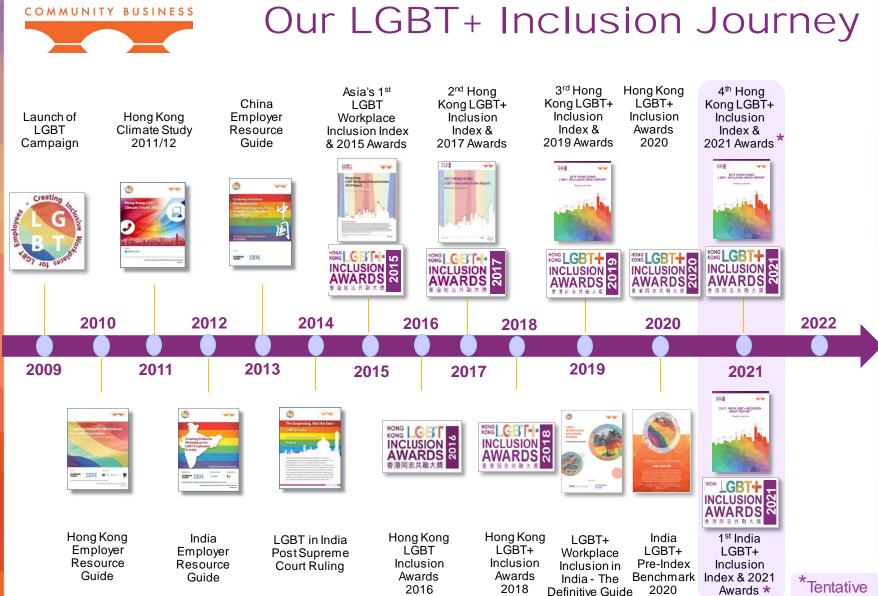

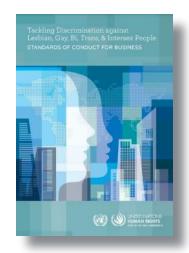
























### Hong Kong LGBT+ Inclusion Index







- Asia's first benchmark for assessing workplace policies and practices for LGBT+ employees
- Provides companies in Hong Kong with a credible and robust tool to assess, progress and promote their efforts towards LGBT+ inclusion
- Run every 2 years 2019 Index was the 3<sup>rd</sup> iteration
- Guiding principles of Index design:
  - ✓ Achievable but credible
  - Straightforward to complete
  - ✓ Celebrate not name and shame

# Purpose of the Index

- Be a driver and catalyst for the adoption of best practice on LGBT+ workplace inclusion in Hong Kong
- Provide organisations with a credible and robust benchmarking tool
- Identify and rank the top performers, providing the motivation for action, creating a sense of competition and capturing the attention of the media and other key stakeholders
- Harness the power of business to drive social change in Hong Kong

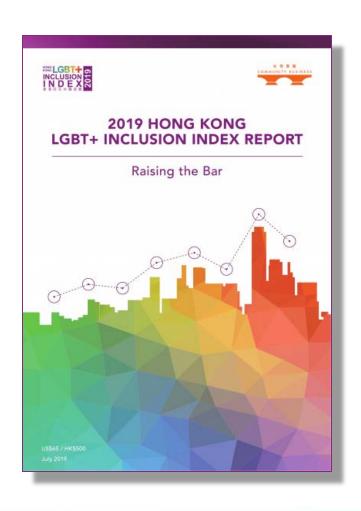

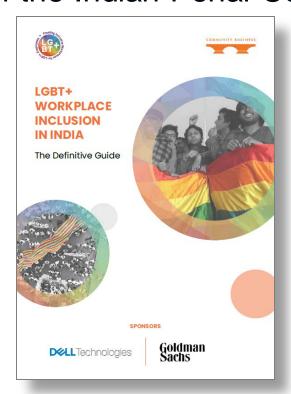
