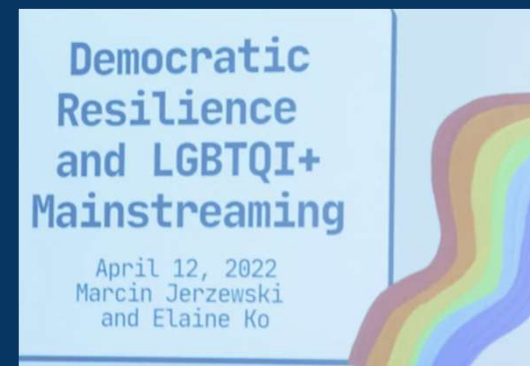
Colombia

Estamos en Elecciones - a website that gathered information about LGBTQI+ candidates ahead of the 2022 elections.



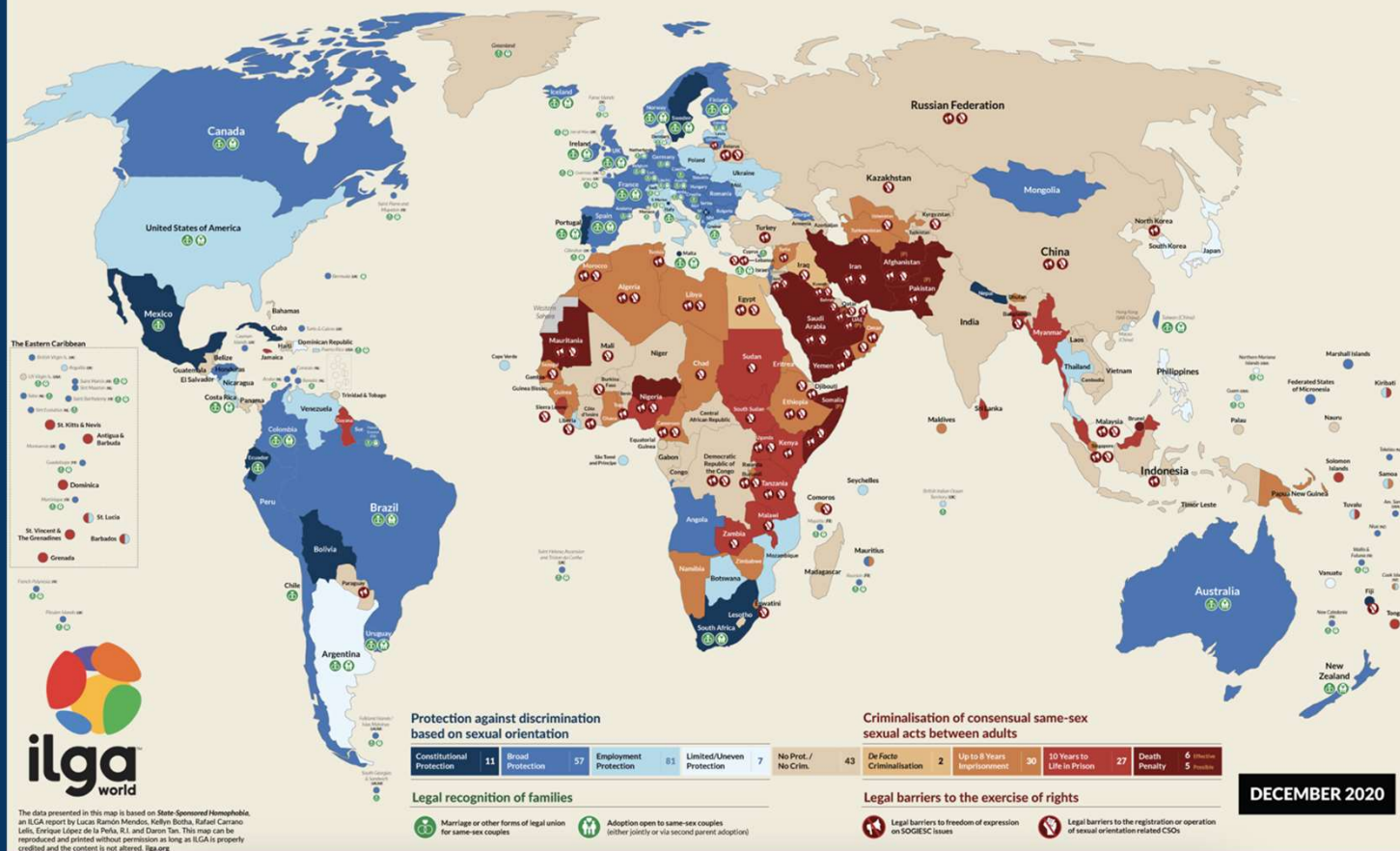
Taiwan

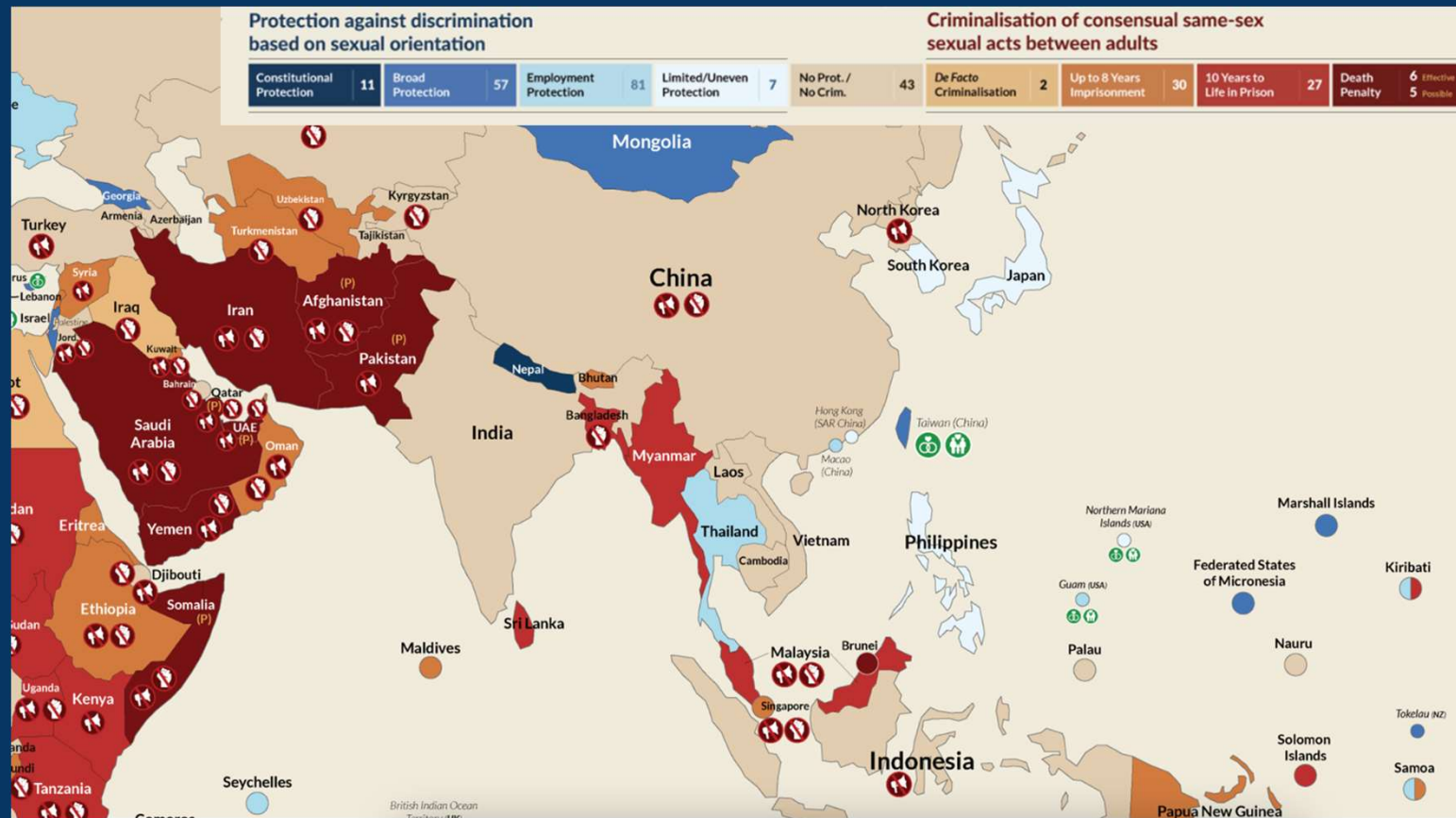
Together with Taiwan NextGen Foundation (TNF), a research project was conducted on LGBTQI+ rights in the context of democratization.
